- work the same hours each week (Monday through Friday) with 40 hours of work guaranteed each week and the opportunity for some overtime work at time and one-half
- increase your understanding of child development and your skill levels with children
- develop a great resume builder, especially for education, psychology, sociology and nursing majors

We are also looking for students who might be interested in teaching tennis or soccer or gardening to groups of our children. If you have this special interest, please indicate that on your employment application.

Please note that we do not provide housing. It is up to the individual student to find his/her own housing for the summer.

We will also need three letters/emails of recommendation, from past employers or professors, which can be emailed or submitted after the job application has been submitted. Application materials can be submitted anytime and preferably prior to March 1. The sooner the better for securing a full time summer job.
