Middle School Math Study

The CLAD Lab at Notre Dame invites students from all local middle schools (**grades 6-8**) to participate in a study examining how middle school students learn math. With funding from the National Science Foundation, we are exploring the strategies students use to solve a variety of non-routine mathematical problems.

To be eligible, students must not have participated in a prior CLAD Lab study this academic year.

Participants will receive:

- Practice solving grade-level standards-based math problems
- \$25 at each session for agreeing to participate and to cover costs associated with traveling to Notre Dame

Time commitment:

- 2 Sessions
- Each session will last between 40-60 minutes
- Sessions times available 2:00 – 7:00 PM
